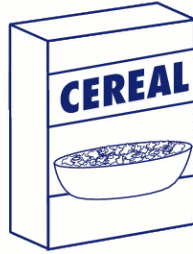


Summer Reading Requirement

Fifth Grade Cereal Box Book Report



- Distributed in the 4th grade report card envelope

Select one book from the 2018-2019 SSYRA book list (enclosed). Read this book over the summer and prepare a cereal box book report based on the directions below.

To Make the Cereal Box:

Materials:

- Clean, empty cereal box
- White or colored drawing paper
- Glue
- Markers and/or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Pencil/pen to write information, or information can be typed

Directions:

- 1- On the front (large side) of the cereal box, illustrate a new cover for your book. This side must contain the title of the book, the author, and your name. Make it colorful and creative!
- 2- On the back (other large side) of the cereal box, write a summary of your book. Your summary of the book should include information about the characters, setting, and problem and solution. The summary should be at least five sentences. You can have an illustration here, too!
- 3- On one small side of the cereal box, write about the characters in the story. This section should include three or more characters, and each character should be described in two or more sentences. You may use a list format.
- 4- On the other small side of the cereal box, write a review about your book. For example, did you like the book? Would you recommend it to others? Why or why not? The book review should be five or more sentences.
