KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

The St. Johns County School District (SJCSD) will hold early registration for children entering kindergarten for the 2017-2018 school year.

Monday, May 15 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

To be eligible for public kindergarten in the SJCSD, children must be 5 years old on or before September 1 and must reside in St. Johns County.

Parents must register children at the school where they are zoned for the 2017-2018 school year. To find your school, enter your street address on the Attendance Zone Locator at <http://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/zoning/>. Students zoned for new Elementary School “M” will need to register at Pacetti Bay Middle School, located at 245 Meadowlark Lane, St. Augustine. Contact the Student Services Department at 547-7598 for additional information on registration and zoning.

Requirements for registration:

- Birth certificate
 - Documentation of a health examination performed on or after August 11, 2016
 - Proof of **completed** required immunizations on Form DH680
 - Proof of residence per the Residency and Guardianship Policy located at www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/student/residency/
 - To register your child for Kindergarten at Timberlin Creek, please see our website at www-tce.stjohns.k12.fl.us
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SMILE! YOU'RE ON CAMERA!

For the safety of our students and all visitors to our campus, 24-hour video cameras (interior and exterior) are in use on our campus.

We must ask that you NOT park in the reserved parking spots. These must be available for the staff that are here late at night.

VIDEOS, PHOTOGRAPHS AND RECORDINGS

Students, parents and visitors are not allowed to videotape, photograph or make audio recordings while on school premises except for Open House and public events (including plays, musicals, fairs, fundraiser raisers, and awards/recognitions.) All recording devices must be turned off at school. The purpose of this general rule is to foster an appropriate educational environment, prevent unwarranted disclosure of student images and information, and to comply with the requirements of the negotiated agreement with the St. Johns Education Association.
