Cell Phones – Parents, we kindly ask that you remain off of your cell phone while in the parent pick-up and drop-off line. There have been several instances where parents have driven up on the curbs due to texting and talking on their phones. The safety of our students, safety patrols, staff, and other families is very important to us. We ask that you help us by putting your phone down while in the line.

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade Families – Please make sure you have access to your child's Home Access Center account (HAC). If you are not able to sign in, please contact Tracy Collins, our computer operator/registrar for your personal login information. Parent Morning Drop-Off – We ask that students arrive by 8:25 each morning to ensure they are in their seats in their classroom prior to 8:30. If your child will need breakfast, we ask that you get them to school with enough time to eat breakfast and be in the classroom by 8:30. Our parent drop-off line opens at 8:05 each morning. Due to the switch of the car loop from last year, the parent drop-off line moves very quickly in the mornings. The safety patrols will move inside the building at 8:25 to ensure they are not late for class.

SMILE! YOU'RE ON CAMERA!
