
OPTIONS FOR VPK AT TIMBERLIN CREEK



WINGS

This program blends students who are typically developing VPK age students with 3 and 4 year old students with varying exceptionalities, such as speech or language delay, developmental delay, visual impairment, hearing impairment or other such delays.

Students who are considered for this program are students who are independent, possibly near the cut off age to be eligible for kindergarten and ready to model classroom behavior for some of our students with special needs.

Rates and Hours for WINGS

- Full School day
 - Drop off is between 7:50 a.m. and 8:25 a.m.
 - Pickup is between 2:35 p.m. and 2:45 p.m. Pickup is one hour early every Wednesday.
 - \$360.00 per Month plus a one time \$100.00 registration fee
- Limited Extended Day Spots are available through Beyond the Bell.

How is the WINGS program different?

- WINGS classrooms are located in the school building.
- VPK students are models for students with exceptionalities.
- Students are eligible to purchase school lunch.
- Students will follow our resource schedule, art, music, PE, and media.
- Certified Early Ed Teachers who specialize in Special Education.
- Ratio We currently have 14 students: 1 teacher and 1 full time paraprofessional. There is also 1 paraprofessional who is shared between two classes. The ratio will vary depending on the number and the needs of our special needs students.
