There have been 2 mou's voted on with Yes votes for 25/26. The mileage is a supplement and is divided into 26 paychecks and not paid as a lump sum. Non instructional will get about 6K from mileage. Instructional voted on a tiered/scaffolded model depending on total years of teaching. They are currently working on administrative amounts.
